**Silver Star Apartment Community for Veterans** is specifically designed to assist homeless Veterans. This 76 unit independent living community provides veterans a place to call home with the services needed to help them lead a normal life.

Located on the campus of The Battle Creek Veteran Affairs Medical Center the community is walking distance to the myriad of services available to all veterans, but presently so hard to manage because of distance and life styles.

Medallion Management through a memorandum of understanding with the Family Home Health Services and Summit Pointe Community Mental Health of Calhoun County assists homeless veterans for placement at this community. Family Home Health Services acts as the Supportive Housing Services coordinator, a full time on-site position. The service coordinators develop personal relationships with the residents and help them with properly filling out forms so they can receive their necessary benefits from the Veterans Administration. They also provide the residents with support and resources for medication compliance, referral resources, and more.



Through a special agreement Medallion Management can provide onsite care givers to help with the everyday routines as well as certain special needs.
